

## **RTRS Annual report of progress Cehave Landbouwbelang**

In our Annual Report 2007 we state "Cehave Landbouwbelang acquires its raw materials in a responsible way and promotes this development by participating in sustainability projects such as the Round Table on Responsible Soy."

Cehave Landbouwbelang is an active member of the Dutch Task Force Sustainable Soy. The goal of the Task Force is to create an effective support for the RTRS and stimulate awareness about the RTRS.

In 2007 we participated, via the Dutch Taskforce, in the financial support of the RTRS, besides our membership fee.

We raised awareness on the RTRS in our own organisation and to our members. Moreover we participated in activities of the Dutch Task Force, such as events on soy production and organising seminars.

We stimulated the criteria development process via support of Marieke Leegwater, the MVO-participant in the RTRS Criteria Development Group.

Our main suppliers of Soybeanmeal are also members of the RTRS, resp. The Dutch Task Force, so they are fully aware of and committed to the process of sustainability.

In 2007 we participated in a special program for one of the leading dairy-companies in our country (also member of the RTRS and the Dutch Task Force) in sourcing responsible soyabeanmeal according to special criteria. At this stage this is a niche market, but the intention is to bring this stream under the criteria of the RTRS, thus being part of the main stream soy.
